Dear All

With reference to Prime Minister's announcement on easing restrictions and 'Return to Play', Clubs can reopen for socially distanced training from Monday 12th April.

Clubs who are registered with the Amateur Boxing Alliance (England) CIC for the current season 20/21, whilst following the Covid-19 Safety measures and guidelines set out by the Alliance (on our website and sent to all clubs), can restart their activities in training Amateur Boxing.

After a year of Covid-19 restrictions / lockdowns and whilst there is a desire for sparring, it must be noted that boxers will not be fully fit and prepared. This is an important safety consideration for Amateur Boxing Alliance (England) CIC on how we safely bring back our sport. Therefore, clubs wishing to restart training must start at Phase 0 (phase description attached), until our action plan has been approved by Sport England and DCMS.

Clubs must adhere to all guidelines set out by us and comply with their Risk Assessment documents; NO SPARRING, No PADWORK or PARTNER ASSISTED EXERCISES until further notice. *Please note that not adhering to government rules and our guidelines could potentially affect your insurance cover.*

The next change will be a significant change and will come into force from 17th May, providing the government data continues to remain positive. Our guidance will reflect this in due course and we are hoping to advance to full training regimes by then.

Please make sure you keep to social distancing in your gyms (2 meters apart), do not allow groups to congregate outside the gym, before or after training. You must also make sure that you keep a concise record of everyone attending your clubs for Track and Tracing purposes (this is a legal requirement).

We hope this projected timetable will allow members and clubs to see some light at the end of the tunnel and that we are moving forward and we will be able to return to competitive boxing soon.
