Dear Members,

The Alliance Board ABA met on the 15th of July 2021.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss urgent business and to start making preparations for the forthcoming season.

We will be issuing general guidance and advising on forthcoming coaching courses and boxing shows in due course.

However, we wanted to communicate an urgent decision from the committee to you as soon as possible.

You will be aware of the rules surrounding medicals. For example, the requirement to undertake a medical if you have not boxed for a year (despite medicals lasting 3 years).

Following discussion, it was felt that in light of these rules and the exceptional circumstances which we have endured in the past 18 months, that we are asking clubs to have all their boxers undertake a medical in preparation of the forthcoming season.

Alliance ABA have a duty of care to its members and we believe our decision to be in the boxer's best interests and compliant with our Rules.

Alliance ABA will issue further guidance in due course but we felt it was necessary to make you aware as soon as possible so that you can plan accordingly.

In order to support our clubs it is proposed that we make clinics available and we will provide further information in due course.
